COVID-19 is having a devastating impact on our community. You deserve accurate information so that you can make desicions for yourself and your family.

MYTH: COVID VACCINES CHANGE YOUR DNA.

FACT: COVID-19 vaccines are designed to help your body's immune system fight the coronavirus. The messenger RNA does enter cells, but not the nucleus of the cells where DNA resides.



MYTH: VACCINES ARE NOT EFFECTIVE.

FACT: People who are vaccinated are much less



MYTH: VACCINES CAN GIVE YOU COVID-19.

FACT: It is impossible for you to become infected with COVID from current vaccines, because they do not contain a live virus.

Side effects like fatigue, headache, runny nose, & soreness are normal. Plan to rest after you get your shot.

Those who do are less likely to become severely ill or die of COVID, and spread less of the virus to others.

MYTH: KIDS CAN'T GET SICK OR DIE FROM COVID.

FACT: More children are testing positive for COVID. While hospitalization and death from are unlikely for children, kids who are hospitalized now are sicker than before, and some have died.



MYTH: COVID VACCINES ARE NOT SAFE FOR PREGNANT PEOPLE.

FACT: Experts recommend that COVID-19 vaccines be available for anyone who is pregnant, breastfeeding, or may want to become pregnant.

In fact, pregnant people who get COVID are more likely to die, give birth pre-term, or develop pre-eclampsia.

Additionally, there is no evidence that COVID-19 vaccines cause infertility.
